CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE OF STUDENTS:

Institute and IQAC have a greater responsibility it building responsible citizens in society. We have greater accountability for developing sound character and expect them to be good conduct in and around the campus. Prepare the students not only in academician quality we focused on preparing students to highest standards of behavior, kindness, helpfulness, and tolerance in any situation.

The following rules were expected to be followed by the students.

- The students shall obey all the rules and regulations made by the institute and the respective departments to conduct themselves with greater discipline and decorum on college premises.
- 2. Every student has to regularly attend the classes and practicals with more remarkable punctuality and responsibility.

- 7. When every class is in session, students are not supposed to enter or leave the course without prior permission of the respective teacher.
- 8. Students are not supposed to move here and there during the sessions.
- 9. After completing the period while moving from one class to another class by corridor or stairs, students are expected to keep themselves left side in a line.
- 10. Students make use of the library whenever classes are not commenced.
- 11. Girls have separate restrooms below the conference hall.
- 12. Every student is expected to handle college properties with respect and care, and they have all right to use them with dignity.
- 13. When every student is free, students can use the library, sports, and gym.
- 14. Any articles damage made by any student, either he has to pay the penalty or replacement will be done.
- 15. Inside the premises, political or communal activities are sterically banned.
- 16. No students shall address any gathering or functions on the college premises without the special permission of the principal or HOD's/Coordinators. The violation of this rule will be liable for the punishment.
- 17. The college student union election or class representative selection will be held in a non-political manner and it has to bring the notice of the principal or HOD's/Coordinators.

- 18. No rallys, loudspeakers, megaphones, etc., should not be used on the campus premises without prior permission.
- 19. Indecent behaviors/ragging/ teasing/ using abusive words towards juniors or the opposite sex is not tolerated if some activity is brought to the notice of the principal or chairman or HODs or coordinator or any teaching faculties. Such conduct bad conduct is seriously considered. Such matters will be immediately reported to higher authorities and followed by the police station.
- 20. As per the direction of the honorable supreme court of India, Govt. of Karnataka, and relevant instruction of VV sangha, VSKU, and UGC, an anti-ragging committee and cell are formed in the college.
- 21. Students are not allowed to bring outsiders or friends to the campus without having prior permission.
- 22. Our college is a plastic-free and tobacco-free campus, so these materials are strictly banned.
- 23. Attain the college function, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities with more extraordinary spirit and enthusiasm, make the college proud and honored.
- 24. No tour, excursions, picnics, or pleasure trips are allowed themselves, and prior permission is required to conduct such a program.
- 25. Students are expected to conduct themselves, respect each other, maintain peace and harmony, and maintain the institution's reputation.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR TEACHERS
